Funding Request: \$65,000

In 2014, CCDC commissioned eight artists, called The Collabortory, to do a deep dive into The Edge as an intensive study of neighborhood character, history, attributes and needs relative to public art. 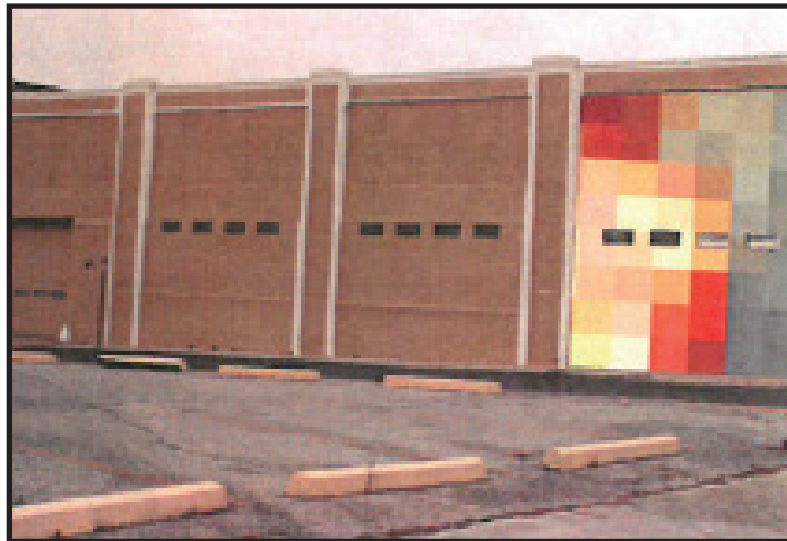
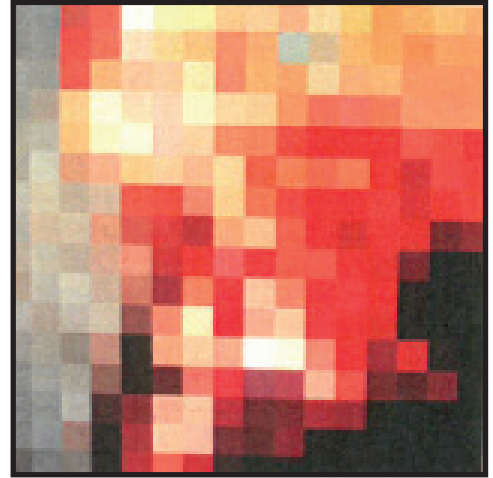
